



CONCORDIA CHRISTIAN SCHOOL K-8TH UNIFORM DRESS CODE

The school uniform is to be worn each school day. All clothing must be clean, in good repair, and be the appropriate size and fit for the student. While this dress code may not fit your personal taste and wardrobe, it is designed to give comfort and flexibility, yet maintain set standards to implement the best possible teaching and learning atmosphere. The administration of Concordia reserves the right to determine inappropriate clothing not specifically covered in this handout. We appreciate your cooperation in adhering to the following guidelines.

SHIRTS

Concordia logo shirts and “spirit shirts” purchased through the school or “polo-type” shirts in solid white, gray, burgundy, navy blue or black are acceptable.

Undershirts or tank tops worn under shirts can be white, gray, burgundy, navy blue or black and may not extend below the hem of the shirt or beyond the sleeves. Therefore, long sleeve undershirts are not permitted under shirts. Undershirts or tank tops worn under Chapel blouses or Chapel dress shirts must be white.

SHORTS / PANTS

Uniform shorts or pants in solid khaki, gray, navy blue or black are acceptable – no cargo pants, sweatpants or jeans.

CAPRIS / SKORTS / SKIRTS

Girls may wear uniform capris, skorts or skirts in solid khaki, gray, navy blue or black. The skorts and skirts must be of modest length. Leggings, jeggings, tights or stockings in solid white, navy blue or black may be worn underneath.

CHAPEL DAY (Wednesday)

- Girls:
- K-2nd – Navy blue uniform **jumpers** or “Marymount” plaid **jumpers** with a white uniform blouse
 - 4th-5th – Navy blue uniform **skirts** or “Marymount” plaid **skirts** with a white uniform blouse
 - 3rd – May choose to wear either the **jumpers** or **skirts** mentioned above

Boys:

- K-5th – Navy blue shorts or pants with a white uniform dress shirt (short or long sleeves)

6th-8th – Middle School students do not have a special dress for chapel. A regular school uniform is required.

OUTER GARMENTS

Sweatshirts, sweaters and light weight jackets can be white, gray, burgundy, navy blue or black or a combination thereof. Both hooded and unhooded sweatshirts are acceptable and may be no larger than **ONE** size bigger than the student actually wears. Winter coats may be any color of your choosing, preferably matching the colors of the school uniform. No words, logos or pictures are allowed on any outer garments, with the exception of Concordia sweatshirts.

SOCKS

Socks in solid white, navy blue or black are permitted.

SHOES

Sturdy athletic shoes are best for the surfaces here at school and for P.E. classes. Shoes must be worn with socks. Shoelaces must not drag on the ground. Platform or heeled shoes, open-toed sandals, flip-flops, plastic jellies, crocs, clogs or boots are not allowed. If rain boots are worn to school, the student must change into appropriate shoes upon arrival.

HATS

Hats in solid white, gray, burgundy, navy blue or black are permitted. Students must remove their hats in the classroom.

HAIR

Hair must be clean and well-groomed with no extreme styles, cuts or coloring and no shaved images. It should be worn in a style that does not cover the face.

OTHER

Students may only wear stud earrings. No other body piercing or visible tattoos are allowed. Temporary tattoos may not be worn, unless granted permission by the principal for special events. Only clear or pale fingernail polish is permitted.
